

New Year's Day Fireworks, Cromer 2015 Photography Competition

On 1st January 2015 we will celebrate Cromer's 16th annual New Year's Day Firework Display which began in 2000.

Now in its third year this photography competition is open to all photographers aged 17+.

The winner of the competition will have their winning photograph turned into the official poster for the 2016 New Year's Day Firework event as well as use in other promotional material. They will also win a prize courtesy of local Electrical retailer Hughes.

Brief: Cromer's Fireworks 2015

We are looking for photographs that really capture the spirit of the New Year's Day Fireworks in Cromer, so come along to Cromer on New Year's Day, bring your camera, photograph the event and get creative.

The competition entry deadline is Wednesday 14 January 2015. All winners will be notified by Monday 2 February 2015.

Photography Competition rules

- 1. Photographs must be taken in Cromer on New Year's Day 2015 and must be original and taken by you. It is the photographer's responsibility to obtain the appropriate permissions. By entering the competition you are agreeing to have the appropriate permissions.
- 2. All photographs must be sent by email (only one photograph per email) or by hard copy and must arrive BEFORE midnight on Wednesday 14 January 2015.
- 3. Photographs may be in colour or black & white.
- 4. Entrants may enter no more than 3 different photographs.
- 5. Emails should be sent to fireworks@cromertown.org and postal copies to Firework Photography Competition, c/o Cromer Town Council Offices, North Lodge, Overstrand Road, Cromer, Norfolk, NR27 0AH.

- 6. Each entry should include the photographers name, address and phone number. (In the email accompany electronic submissions and on the back of hard copy submissions).
- 7. Photographs must be in JPEG format for electronic submissions or at size 7x5 or larger for hard copy submissions.
- 8. Photographs submitted by email should be no larger than 3MB.
- 9. Photographs submitted by email should contain no watermark.
- 10. The competition is open to all photographers aged 17+.
- 11. All commercial rights to the images remain with the photographers with the following exception:
 - a. The New Year's Day Fireworks committee has the right to use all entries in any future publicity material (print or electronic inc. Social Media) without payment subject to crediting the original photographer. This includes the right to grant use of the image by third parties solely for the purpose of promoting future events.
- 12. The competition will be judged by representatives of Cromer's New Year's Day Fireworks as well as at least one guest judge. Winners will be notified by email or phone, the judge's decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered into. Prizes are non-negotiable and non-transferable.
- 13. Judging will take place from Monday 19 January 2015 and winners will be notified by Monday 2 February 2015.
- 14. By entering the competition you agree to participate in any reasonable publicity which may be generated as a result of the competition.
